Jesus teaches, preaches and cures in Galilee, seeing the people's depression and hunger for encouragement. He tells His disciples that the rich harvest has too few labourers. Then He commissions the Twelve: "Proclaim the nearness of the kingdom. Cure the sick, raise the dead, and drive out devils. You received without charge; give without charge."

When Jesus met people, He realized that often it's difficult to see past the burden of everyday life. Yet they began to believe that the kingdom might be near because Jesus healed bodies and spirits with His hands and words. What about us? Do our words heal or wound?
