Feasts of Saint Peter and Paul

We celebrate today the foundation of the Church in St Peter and the missionary arm in St Paul. These two pillars of the Church teach us through God's dealings with them how to love God and lead his people. Peter full of human characteristics and failings, was to become the rock on which the Church was founded.

Paul a violent and zealous persecutor became a missionary and apostle. At the heart of their transformation was their insight in to Jesus. The Father allowed Peter to glimpse the greatest mystery of all, God had sent his Son, that God's Son had become a human being. At the moment Peter's view of Jesus changed for ever. He saw that the human Jesus was in fact the divine Son. This light equipped him to be the rock upon which Christ would build his Church.

Paul too, was adamant that his insight into Christ was the fruit of personal revelation (Gal: 1:12). He wasn't taught it by any human means, but learnt it directly from his own encounter with the living God on the road to Damascus.

Today we pray especially for Pope Benedict successor of St Peter and for our Archbishop.

A collection today will be taken for PETER'S PENCE, which is the annual offering to help the Pope's expenses.

There will be possible alterations to Masses for the week 20th - 27th June 2010. At the time of printing this Newsletter the Mass times are as stipulated but could be changed to Eucharistic Services, if there is no Priest to take the service.
