14th Sunday of Ordinary Time (Lk 10:1-9)

We walk together on a journey of faith

We are like the disciples that Jesus sent before him to offer peace to every town he was to visit. We walk in faith. It would be easy to lose our way but we have the disciples, men and women who have walked before us in loneliness and fear, doubts and rejection, men and women who have walked with courage and hope, with determination and joy. Their footprints are everywhere. We need only open our eyes to see the faith and open our hearts to walk its way.

Jesus sent the disciples in pairs to offer peace to others. How joyful we should be to share and work together in our peace mission.

Our mission may not be to foreign lands or even places away from our neighbourhood. Our peace mission could simply be seeing and accepting all people as our brothers and sisters regardless of race or colour.

We are sent to pre-evangelise, to prepare the people to hear the word of God and accept it in their lives. We provide an environment of welcome and an atmosphere of trust. In our offering of peace, we free others to be created anew. And like the disciples, we take pride in doing God's will and are joyful that our names are inscribed in heaven.
